Rules and Regulations:

- 1. EACH TEAM MUST HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER ON HAND.
- 2. Each team will have a 12' x 16' area.
- 3. Each contestant and/or vendor shall check-in upon arrival at the main gate.
- **4.** A contestant number and a cooking area will be assigned.
- **5.** Each team will be responsible for supplying all of their own supplies, ingredients, cooking devices, utensils, prep and serving tables, etc.
- **6.** Teams will receive 4 (four) admission tickets. All other guests/family will need to purchase additional tickets for \$5.00 at the gate or with Entry Form. (This is a fundraiser; we appreciate your understanding!)
- 7. Trash bags will be provided by each individual team/contestant. A dumpster for trash will be onsite.
- **8.** One electric hook-up available per team.
- 9. No live animals allowed on the property at any time.
- **10.** The team's captain is responsible for the conduct of his/her team and its guests. Teams are not to play loud music nor with profanity. We will have a DJ providing music and announcements in the park.
- 11. Under NO circumstances are alcoholic beverages are to be brought into the park, given away or sold. Beverages may be purchased from the KC's on the day of the event. In addition, no wings are to be purchased and/or brought into the event. Immediate disqualification.
- **12.** Wing Fling and Knights of Columbus Council #2801 requests and requires good taste be used regarding team conduct during all times. STRICTLY ENFORCED!
- 13. The Wing Fling and Knights of Columbus #2801 is not responsible for items left unattended at any time.
- **14.** Read and keep these rules during the event. If there are any questions or concerns, please contact a Wing Fling representative immediately for clarification. We want everyone to have an enjoyable experience.
- **15.** The Wing Fling and Knights of Columbus #2801 reserves the right to make additional, purge, or modify rules and regulations. All decisions are final.

Cooking:

- 1. To ensure all wings are the same, it is required that teams pick up their wings from the KC'S at 10 AM following the Cook's Meeting. Approximately 25 lbs. of wings will be provided for judging and guests. **EXTRA WINGS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE**
- 2. Everything must be cooked on site during the hours of competition. Any pre-cooked items will result in disqualification. Teams must have a Captain and Assistant.
- 3. Teams will provide 10 fully cooked wings of each category for judging.
- 4. Remaining Wings shall be prepared and available for sampling by the public by 1:00 PM.
- 5. Each team must have hand cleaning capabilities. Soap and water and waterless hand sanitizers are accepted.

 We will need to follow CDC Regulations if applicable.
- 6. All teams are expected to keep wings chilled and fresh before cooking as well as hot when serving.
- 7. ALL teams are expected to maintain sanitary conditions. Teams must provide their own tables, chairs, chafing dishes, cooking utensils, paper towels etc...LET'S KEEP IT CLEAN!!

Judging:

- 1. Judges will consist of a panel selected by the Wing Fling event. The judging will be anonymous.
- 2. There will be 3 (three) categories.
 - A. Classic Buffalo Style
 - B. BBQ Style Fried or Grilled
 - C. **Open** (no limits, give us your best wing!)
- 3. Each team shall turn in a container with 10 (ten) wings for each category and sauce when applicable. No garnish other than green lettuce will be allowed in the container.
- 4. See Schedule for Judging Times.
- 5. All Judges Decisions are final.
- 6. **NO LATE TURN IN ACCEPTED.**
- 7. Wings deemed to be too spicy hot or undercooked for judging will be disqualified.

Prizes:

- 1. Each category will receive 1st, 2nd & 3rd place trophies.
- 2. An overall winner will also be awarded. Entry Fee will be paid for the 2024 Wing Fling Event.
- 3. People's Choice will receive an engraved cutting board.

Clean-Up:

- 1. All areas must be cleaned up by 7:00 PM.
- 2. Metal Barrel will be on-site for Disposal of Ash and coals from Grills. DO NOT DUMP ON GROUND.
- 3. EACH TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GREASE DISPOSAL. NO GREASE IN TRASH CANS OR DUMPSTERS.
